End of June started Colorguard Tech Camp and then Choreography Camp. July WAS BUSY! We had Percussion Camp, Rookie Camp, and most importantly Band Camp! We ended our summer with our annual Parent Show on July 30th.

## Marching Band schedule

The football season has started and we have already participated in 2 home games. ## Fundraisers

Back in June, we started a DonorsChoose project to help replace our 20+ year old bass drums. In just 7 days, donors all over the country helped us out and we were able to get 3 brand new bass drums. We plan on doing it again to see if we can replace our tenor/quad drums. Over Band Camp we started a VerticalRaise fundraiser that is similar to DonorsChoose. Students sent out emails and family and friends could donate. We also sold FundRays coupon books. All 3 fundraisers were very successful for the band and Band Boosters! We will do 1 more fundraiser closer to November (a Boston Butt sale) for all your Iron Bowl parties.

## What's Ahead

To switch gears, Concert Season is approaching **fast**. Auditions for the 3 "sit down" bands we offer will be the last week of October. Tuesday 10/26 will be woodwinds and Thursday 10/28 will be brass, both after school. Percussion will be all week during class. Depending on your audition, you will be placed in an ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, or Concert Band. Our first performance will be a Christmas concert on Tuesday December 7 at 6:30pm in the Auditorium which is mandatory. \*Please see calendar on website\*

In January, when we return after the break, students will be in their assigned band ensemble class and our primary goal will be the annual Music Performance Assessment that we host for our District.

Students also have the opportunity to audition for Mobile County's Honor Band Clinic. This will be held at Davidson HS (after school) on November 18, 2021.
